CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, June 28, 2007, or Friday, June 29,
4 2007, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
5 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
6 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, July 10, 2007, or until
7 the time of any reassembly pursuant to

1 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
 2 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
 3 Friday, June 29, 2007, Saturday, June 30, 2007, Sunday,
 4 July 1, 2007, or Monday, July 2, 2007, on a motion of-
 5 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-
 6 ity Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned
 7 until noon on Monday, July 9, 2007, or such other time
 8 on that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader
 9 or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
 10 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this
 11 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

12 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
 13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
 14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
 15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
 16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
 17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
 18 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant
 19 it.
