## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress with respect to countries that withdraw from the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that the  
3 President should direct the United States Permanent Rep-  
4 resentative to the United Nations to use the vote, voice,  
5 and influence of the United States to urge the United Na-  
6 tions Security Council to pass a resolution under Chapter  
7 VII of the United Nations Charter that—

8            (1) requires any country that withdraws from  
9        the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear  
10        Weapons, done at Washington, London and Moscow

1 on July 1, 1968, and entered into force on March  
2 5, 1970 (21 UST 483) (hereinafter in this resolution  
3 referred to as the “Treaty”), to be held responsible  
4 for any violations by the country of the Treaty’s re-  
5 quirements that occurred before the country’s with-  
6 drawal from the Treaty; and

7 (2) prohibits any country that withdraws from  
8 the Treaty after the country is determined to be in  
9 noncompliance with any of the Treaty’s require-  
10 ments, including any applicable safeguards agree-  
11 ments, from using or retaining any nuclear energy  
12 assets, including all items listed in the current  
13 version of the International Atomic Energy Agency  
14 trigger list, published in INFCIRC/254 parts 1 and  
15 2, acquired from other parties to the Treaty while  
16 the country was a party to the Treaty.
