Mr. JONES of North Carolina introduced the following joint resolution; which
was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

JOINT RESOLUTION

Concerning the use of military force by the United States
against Iran.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS CONCERNING THE USE OF**
4 **MILITARY FORCE AGAINST IRAN.**

5 (a) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—No provision of law
6 enacted before the date of the enactment of this joint reso-
7 lution shall be construed to authorize the use of military
8 force by the United States against Iran.

9 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—Absent a national emergency
10 created by attack by Iran, or a demonstrably imminent
11 attack by Iran, upon the United States, its territories or

1 possessions or its armed forces, the President shall consult
2 with Congress, and receive specific authorization pursuant
3 to law from Congress, prior to initiating any use of mili-
4 tary force against Iran.
