JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States allowing castration after conviction for the rape of a child under 16 years of age.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
- 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 9 for ratification:

1 "ARTICLE —

2 "Upon conviction for the rape of a child under the

3 age of 16 years old, surgical or chemical castration is per-

4 mitted under this Constitution and does not constitute

5 cruel and unusual punishment.".
