## A BILL

To amend the National Guard Youth Challenge Program under title 32, United States Code, to exclude nondefense funds made available by other Federal agencies for the Program from the matching requirements of the Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR STATE PROGRAMS**  
2 **UNDER THE NATIONAL GUARD YOUTH CHAL-**  
3 **LENCE PROGRAM.**

4 (a) FEDERAL SHARE OF COSTS OF STATE PRO-  
5 GRAMS.—Subsection (d) of section 509 of title 32, United  
6 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 “(d) DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SHARE OF STATE  
8 PROGRAM COSTS.—The amount of assistance provided  
9 under this section to a State program of the Program for  
10 a fiscal year using funds appropriated directly to the Sec-  
11 retary of Defense may not exceed 60 percent of the costs  
12 of operating the State program during that year. However,  
13 nondefense funds made available or transferred to the Sec-  
14 retary of Defense by other Federal agencies to support  
15 the Program or provided directly by other Federal agen-  
16 cies in support of the Program shall not be subject to the  
17 matching-funds requirement imposed by the preceding  
18 sentence.”.

19 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For fis-  
20 cal year 2008, there is authorized to be appropriated to  
21 the Secretary of Defense \$97,527,200 to carry out the Na-  
22 tional Guard Youth Challenge Program under section 509  
23 of title 32, United States Code.
