## A BILL

To allow postal patrons to contribute to funding for gang prevention programs through the voluntary purchase of certain specially issued postage stamps.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stamp Out Gang Vio-
- 5 lence Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. SPECIAL POSTAGE STAMP.
- 7 (a) In General.—In order to afford a convenient
- 8 way for members of the public to contribute to funding

- 1 for gang prevention programs, the United States Postal
- 2 Service shall provide for a special postage stamp in accord-
- 3 ance with subsection (b).
- 4 (b) Terms and Conditions.—The issuance and sale
- 5 of the stamp referred to in subsection (a) shall be gov-
- 6 erned by section 416 of title 39, United States Code, and
- 7 regulations under such section, subject to the following:
- 8 (1) Disposition of Proceeds.—All amounts
- 9 becoming available from the sale of such stamp shall
- be transferred to the Gang Resistance Education
- and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) Program, administered
- by the Office of Justice Programs of the Depart-
- ment of Justice, through payments which shall be
- made at least twice a year.
- 15 (2) DURATION.—Such stamp shall be made
- available to the public for a period of at least 2
- years, beginning no later than 12 months after the
- date of the enactment of this Act.
- 19 (3) LIMITATION.—Such stamp shall not be
- counted for purposes of applying any numerical limi-
- 21 tation under subsection (e)(1)(C) of such section.
