- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Professional Driver
- 5 Background Check Efficiency Act of 2007".

1	SEC. 2. BACKGROUND RECORDS CHECKS FOR MOTOR VE-
2	HICLE LICENSES FOR THE TRANSPORTATION
3	OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.
4	Section 5103a(d) of title 49, United States Code, is
5	amended by adding at the end the following:
6	"(3) Cost.—The total amount of a fee imposed
7	upon a person to cover costs, including administra-
8	tive and other costs, associated with carrying out a
9	background records check under this section shall
10	not exceed \$50.
11	"(4) Assistance to states.—The Secretary
12	may reimburse a State for costs incurred by the
13	State in connection with background records checks
14	carried out under this section.".
