## A BILL

To prohibit any Federal official from expending any Federal funds for any population control or population planning program or any family planning activity.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Taxpayers’ Freedom  
5 of Conscience Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST FEDERAL FUNDING FOR**  
2 **POPULATION CONTROL.**

3 No Federal official may expend any Federal funds  
4 for any population control or population planning program  
5 or any family planning activity (including any abortion  
6 procedure), irrespective of whether such program or activ-  
7 ity is foreign or domestic.
