A BILL

To prohibit any Federal official from expending any Federal funds for any population control or population planning program or any family planning activity.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Taxpayers' Freedom
- 5 of Conscience Act of 2007".

1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST FEDERAL FUNDING FOR

- 2 **POPULATION CONTROL.**
- 3 No Federal official may expend any Federal funds
- 4 for any population control or population planning program
- 5 or any family planning activity (including any abortion
- 6 procedure), irrespective of whether such program or activ-
- 7 ity is foreign or domestic.
