## A BILL

To suspend the visa waiver program until certain entry-exit control requirements are met, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Secure Entry Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF VISA WAIVER PROGRAM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
7 sion of law, the visa waiver program established under sec-  
8 tion 217 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
9 1187) is hereby suspended until such time as the Sec-

1   retary of Homeland Security determines and certifies to  
2   Congress that—

3           (1) the automated entry-exit control system au-  
4           thorized under section 110 of the Illegal Immigra-  
5           tion Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of  
6           1996 (8 U.S.C. 1221 note) is fully implemented and  
7           functional;

8           (2) all United States ports of entry have func-  
9           tional biometric machine readers; and

10          (3) all nonimmigrants, including Border Cross-  
11          ing Card holders, are processed through the auto-  
12          mated entry-exit control system.

13          (b)   REPEAL.—Subparagraph   (B)   of   section  
14   217(a)(3) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
15   U.S.C. 1187(a)(3)) is hereby repealed.
