## A BILL

- 10 (a) Survey Required Every Five Years.—In fis-
- 11 cal year 2008, and every five fiscal years thereafter, the
- 12 Secretary of Agriculture shall carry out a nationwide sur-
- 13 vey on the foods purchased by school authorities with Fed-
- 14 eral cash assistance. Each survey shall cover the purchases
- 15 made during the preceding fiscal year.
- 16 (b) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than February 1

## SEC. 3. FUNDING FOR FREE LUNCH AND BREAKFAST ELIGI-2 BILITY PILOT PROGRAM. 3 Section 18(k) of the Richard B. Russell National 4 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1769(k)) is amended by 5 adding at the end the following: "(5) Mandatory transfers of funds.—Out 6 7 of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appro-8 priated, the Secretary of the Treasury shall transfer 9 to the Secretary of Agriculture, to remain available 10 until expended— 11 "(A) on October 1, 2007, \$10,000,000 to 12 carry out paragraph (1); "(B) on October 1, 2008, \$10,000,000 to 13 14 carry out paragraph (1); and "(C) on October 1, 2009, \$3,000,000 to 15 16 carry out paragraph (3).".
