## A BILL

To repeal a provision enacted to end Federal matching of State spending of child support incentive payments.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Protec-  
5 tion Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF PROVISION ENACTED TO END FEDERAL**  
2 **MATCHING OF STATE SPENDING OF CHILD**  
3 **SUPPORT INCENTIVE PAYMENTS.**

4 Section 7309 of the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005  
5 is repealed.
