A BILL

To require Senate confirmation of an individual appointed
to serve as the Director of the American Institute in Taiwan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SENATE CONFIRMATION REQUIRED OF AN IN-**
4 **DIVIDUAL APPOINTED TO SERVE AS DIREC-**
5 **TOR OF THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE IN TAI-**
6 **WAN.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, the President shall appoint, by and with the
9 advice and consent of the Senate, an individual to serve
10 as the Director of the American Institute in Taiwan.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
2 beginning with the first appointment by the President of
3 an individual to serve as the Director of the American In-
4 stitute in Taiwan that is made after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act.
