## A BILL

To amend the Organic Foods Production Act of 1990 to prohibit the labeling of cloned livestock and products derived from cloned livestock as organic.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF CLONED LIVESTOCK.**

4       Section 2103 of the Organic Foods Production Act  
5 of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 6502) is amended—

6               (1) by redesignating paragraphs (6) through  
7               (21) as paragraphs (7) through (22) respectively;  
8               and

9               (2) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-  
10              lowing:

1           “(6) CLONED LIVESTOCK.—The term ‘cloned  
2       livestock’ means—

3           “(A) livestock produced as the result of so-  
4       matic cell nuclear transfer or other asexual re-  
5       production technologies; and

6           “(B) the progeny of such livestock.”.

7 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR ORGANIC PRODUC-  
8       TION.**

9       Section 2105 of the Organic Foods Production Act  
10 of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 6504) is amended—

11           (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the  
12       end;

13           (2) by redesignating paragraph (3) as para-  
14       graph (4); and

15           (3) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-  
16       lowing:

17           “(3) not be cloned livestock, or produced or de-  
18       rived from or containing any part of cloned livestock;  
19       and”.
