Mr. DANIEL E. LUNGREN of California (for himself and Mr. McCARTHY of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

To create 4 new permanent judgeships for the eastern district of California.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NEW JUDGESHIPS FOR EASTERN DISTRICT OF  
4       CALIFORNIA.**

5       (a) NEW APPOINTMENTS.—The President shall ap-  
6       point, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,  
7       4 additional district judges for the eastern district of Cali-  
8       fornia.

9       (b) TABLE.—In order that the table contained in sec-  
10      tion 133(a) of title 28, United States Code, reflects the

1 total number of permanent district judgeships authorized  
2 by virtue of subsection (a) of this section, such table is  
3 amended by striking the item relating to California and  
4 inserting the following:

“California	
Northern .....	14
Eastern .....	10
Central .....	27
Southern .....	13”.

5       (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
6 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be  
7 necessary to carry out this section, including such sums  
8 as may be necessary to provide appropriate space and fa-  
9 cilities for the judicial positions created by this section.
