## A BILL

To amend section 1369 of title 18, United States Code, to extend Federal jurisdiction over destruction of veterans' memorials on State or local government property.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Protect our Veterans  
5       Memorials Act of 2007”.

6       **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7       Congress finds that—

8               (1) crimes against United States military vet-  
9       erans' memorials on public property dishonor all

1 American servicemen and women and their sacrifices  
2 for the Nation's defense; and

3 (2) Federal prosecution of crimes against such  
4 veterans' memorials on public property is in the na-  
5 tional interest of honoring the Nation's military vet-  
6 erans.

7 **SEC. 3. FEDERAL JURISDICTION OVER DESTRUCTION OF**  
8 **VETERANS' MEMORIALS ON STATE OR LOCAL**  
9 **GOVERNMENT PROPERTY.**

10 Section 1369(b)(2) of title 18, United States Code,  
11 is amended by inserting “, or a State or local government”  
12 after “Federal Government”.
