# H. R. 1489

To amend title XXI of the Social Security Act to eliminate the remainder of the funding shortfalls in the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) for fiscal year 2007.

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## A BILL

To amend title XXI of the Social Security Act to eliminate the remainder of the funding shortfalls in the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) for fiscal year 2007.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF REMAINDER OF SCHIP FUND-**  
4 **ING SHORTFALLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007.**

5 (a) ELIMINATION OF REMAINDER OF FUNDING  
6 SHORTFALLS, TIERED MATCH, AND OTHER LIMITATION  
7 ON EXPENDITURES.—Section 2104(h) of the Social Secu-

1 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1397dd(h)), as added by section  
2 201(a) of the National Institutes of Health Reform Act  
3 of 2006 (Public Law 109–482), is amended—

4 (1) in the heading for paragraph (2), by strik-  
5 ing “REMAINDER OF REDUCTION” and inserting  
6 “PART OF”; and

7 (2) by striking paragraph (4) and inserting the  
8 following:

9 “(4) ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS TO ELIMINATE RE-  
10 MAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2007 FUNDING SHORT-  
11 FALLS.—

12 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall  
13 allot to each remaining shortfall State described  
14 in subparagraph (B) such amount as the Sec-  
15 retary determines will eliminate the estimated  
16 shortfall described in such subparagraph for the  
17 State for fiscal year 2007.

18 “(B) REMAINING SHORTFALL STATE DE-  
19 SCRIBED.—For purposes of subparagraph (A),  
20 a remaining shortfall State is a State with a  
21 State child health plan approved under this title  
22 for which the Secretary estimates, on the basis  
23 of the most recent data available to the Sec-  
24 retary as of the date of the enactment of this  
25 paragraph, that the projected federal expendi-

1           tures under such plan for the State for fiscal  
2           year 2007 will exceed the sum of—

3                   “(i) the amount of the State’s allot-  
4                   ments for each of fiscal years 2005 and  
5                   2006 that will not be expended by the end  
6                   of fiscal year 2006;

7                   “(ii) the amount of the State’s allot-  
8                   ment for fiscal year 2007; and

9                   “(iii) the amounts, if any, that are to  
10                  be redistributed to the State during fiscal  
11                  year 2007 in accordance with paragraphs  
12                  (1) and (2).

13               “(C) APPROPRIATION; ALLOTMENT AU-  
14               THORITY.—For the purpose of providing addi-  
15               tional allotments to remaining shortfall States  
16               under this paragraph there is appropriated, out  
17               of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise ap-  
18               propriated, such sums as are necessary for fis-  
19               cal year 2007.”.

20           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 2104(h)  
21   of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1397dd(h)) (as so added), is  
22   amended—

23               (1) in paragraph (1)(B), by striking “subject to  
24               paragraph (4)(B) and”;

1           (2) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “subject to  
2     paragraph (4)(B) and”;

3           (3) in paragraph (5)(A), by striking “and (3)”  
4     and inserting “(3), and (4)”; and

5           (4) in paragraph (6), by striking “and (3)” and  
6     inserting “(3), and (4)”.

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
