A BILL

To treat certain payments made by Edmond, Oklahoma, as satisfying its obligations under the water storage control for Lake Arcadia, Oklahoma, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARCADIA LAKE, OKLAHOMA.**

4 Payments made by the city of Edmond, Oklahoma,
5 to the Secretary of the Army in October 1999 of costs
6 associated with present and future water storage at Arca-
7 dia Lake, Oklahoma, under Arcadia Lake Water Storage
8 Contract Number DACW56–79–C–0072 shall satisfy the

1 obligations of the city under that contract for such costs,
2 including accrued interest.

3 **SEC. 2. OKLAHOMA LAKE DEMONSTRATION, OKLAHOMA.**

4 (a) RELEASE OF RETAINED RIGHTS, INTERESTS,
5 AND RESERVATIONS.—Each reversionary interest and use
6 restriction relating to public parks and recreation on the
7 land conveyed by the Secretary of the Army to the State
8 of Oklahoma at Lake Texoma pursuant to the Act entitled
9 “An Act to authorize the sale of certain lands to the State
10 of Oklahoma” (67 Stat. 63) is terminated.

11 (b) INSTRUMENT OF RELEASE.—As soon as prac-
12 ticable after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-
13 retary shall execute and file in the appropriate office a
14 deed of release, an amended deed, or another appropriate
15 instrument to release each interest and use restriction de-
16 scribed in subsection (a).
