# H. R. 1668

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to provide that an individual's entitlement to any benefit thereunder shall continue through the month of his or her death (without affecting any other person's entitlement to benefits for that month) and that such individual's benefit shall be payable for such month only to the extent proportionate to the number of days in such month preceding the date of such individual's death.

9	of days in such month preceding the date of
10	such individual's death, and
11	"(B) the denominator of which is the num-
12	ber of days in such month, rounded, if not a
13	multiple of \$1, to the next lower multiple of \$1,
14	rounded, if not a multiple of \$1, to the next lower multiple
15	of \$1. This subsection shall apply with respect to such
16	benefit after all other adjustments with respect to such
17	benefit provided by this title have been made. Payment
18	of such benefit for such month shall be made as provided
19	in section 204(d).".
20	(c) Benefits at Age 72 for Certain Uninsured
21	Individuals.—Section 228 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 428)
22	is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
23	section:

2	"(i) The amount of any individual's monthly benefit
3	under this section paid for the month in which the indi-
4	vidual dies shall be an amount equal to—
5	"(1) the amount of such benefit (as determined
6	without regard to this subsection), multiplied by
7	"(2) a fraction—
8	"(A) the numerator of which is the number
9	of days in such month preceding the date of
10	such individual's death, and
11	"(B) the denominator of which is the num-
12	ber of days in such month, rounded, if not a
13	multiple of \$1, to the next lower multiple of \$1.
14	rounded, if not a multiple of \$1, to the next lower multiple
15	of \$1. This subsection shall apply with respect to such
16	benefit after all other adjustments with respect to such
17	benefit provided by this title have been made. Payment
18	of such benefit for such month shall be made as provided
19	in section 204(d).".
20	SEC. 4. DISREGARD OF BENEFIT FOR MONTH OF DEATH
21	UNDER FAMILY MAXIMUM PROVISIONS.
22	Section 203(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
23	403(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following
24	new paragraph:

- 1 "(11) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 2 Act, in applying the preceding provisions of this subsection
- 3 (and determining maximum family benefits under column
- 4 V of the table in or deemed to be in section 215(a) as
- 5 in effect in December 1978) with respect to the month
- 6 in which the insured individual's death occurs, the benefit
- 7 payable to such individual for that month shall be dis-
- 8 regarded.".

## 9 SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
- 11 respect to deaths occurring after the month in which this
- 12 Act is enacted.
