Mr. MOORE of Kansas (for himself, Mr. HASTINGS of Florida, Ms. HIRONO, Mr. HOLT, Mr. McCAUL of Texas, Mr. REYES, Mr. SHAYS, and Mr. WEXLER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To provide additional student loan forgiveness to teachers of foreign languages.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Language
5 Education Expansion Act”.

6 SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL LOAN FORGIVENESS FOR TEACHERS 7 OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES.

8 (a) FFEL LOANS.—Section 428J(c)(3)(A)(ii) of the
9 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1078–

1 10(c)(3)(A)(ii)) is amended by striking “mathematics or
2 science” and inserting “mathematics, science, or a foreign
3 language”.

4 (b) DIRECT LOANS.—Section 460(c)(3)(A)(ii) of
5 such Act (20 U.S.C. 1087j(c)(3)(A)(ii)) is amended by
6 striking “mathematics or science” and inserting “mathe-
7 matics, science, or a foreign language”.

8 (c) NEW BORROWER ELIGIBILITY.—An individual
9 who is a teacher of a foreign language shall not qualify
10 under the amendments made by this section unless such
11 individual is a new borrower (as such term is defined in
12 section 103 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
13 U.S.C. 1003)) on or after October 1, 2001.
