## A BILL

To amend the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act to extend from 90 days to one year the period after release of a member of the Armed Forces from active duty during which the member is protected from mortgage foreclosure under that Act.

6       (a) EXTENSION TO 12 MONTHS.—Section 303(c) of  
7       the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (50 U.S.C. App.

1 533(c)) is amended by striking “90 days” and inserting  
2 “one year”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any person per-  
5 forming a period of military service (as such term is de-  
6 fined in section 101(2) of such Act (50 U.S.C. App.  
7 511(2))) that begins on or after February 1, 2003.
