A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that Federal employees stationed in American Samoa shall be paid the same nonforeign area cost-of-living allowance as if stationed in Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EQUAL TREATMENT FOR EMPLOYEES STA-**
4 **TIONED IN AMERICAN SAMOA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5941 of title 5, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

1 “(c) An employee stationed in American Samoa shall
2 be paid the same allowance under subsection (a) as if sta-
3 tioned in Guam or the Commonwealth of the Northern
4 Mariana Islands.”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall take effect as of the first day of the
7 first fiscal year beginning at least 3 months after the date
8 of the enactment of this Act.
