Mr. MACK (for himself, Mr. MARIO DIAZ-BALART of Florida, Mr. BUCHANAN, and Mr. MAHONEY of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 2000.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring the
5 Caloosahatchee River: A Legacy for Florida”.

6 **SEC. 2. WEST BASIN RESERVOIR.**

7 Section 601(b)(2) of the Water Resources Develop-
8 ment Act of 2000, 114 Stat. 2682, is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (C)—

10 (A) by striking the first dollar amount and
11 inserting “\$1,545,918,000”;

1 (B) by striking the second dollar amount
2 and inserting “\$772,959,000”;

3 (C) by striking the third dollar amount
4 and inserting “\$772,959,000” and

5 (2) by adding at the end of subparagraph (C)
6 the following:

7 “(xii) C-43 Basin Storage Reservoir
8 and Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project
9 (Phase I—West Basin Reservoir), at a
10 total cost of \$445,000,000, with an esti-
11 mated Federal cost of \$222,500,000 and
12 an estimated non-Federal cost of
13 \$222,500,000, and, with water quality im-
14 provement features determined necessary
15 by the Secretary to achieve the restoration
16 of the ecosystem.”.
