- 3 SECTION 1. ROSA PARKS COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE
- 4 STAMP.
- 5 (a) In General.—The Postmaster General shall
- 6 issue a commemorative postage stamp in honor of Rosa
- 7 Parks.
- 8 (b) DENOMINATION; DESIGNS.—The commemorative
- 9 postage stamp issued under this Act shall be issued in the
- 10 denomination used for first class mail up to one ounce in

- 1 weight and shall bear such designs as the Postmaster Gen-
- 2 eral shall determine.
- 3 (c) Issuance Period.—The commemorative postage
- 4 stamp issued under this Act shall be placed on sale as
- 5 soon as practicable after the date of the enactment of this
- 6 Act and shall be sold for such period thereafter as the
- 7 Postmaster General shall determine.
