A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a commemorative postage
stamp in honor of Rosa Parks.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ROSA PARKS COMMEMORATIVE POSTAGE**
4 **STAMP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Postmaster General shall
6 issue a commemorative postage stamp in honor of Rosa
7 Parks.

8 (b) DENOMINATION; DESIGNS.—The commemorative
9 postage stamp issued under this Act shall be issued in the
10 denomination used for first class mail up to one ounce in

1 weight and shall bear such designs as the Postmaster Gen-
2 eral shall determine.

3 (c) ISSUANCE PERIOD.—The commemorative postage
4 stamp issued under this Act shall be placed on sale as
5 soon as practicable after the date of the enactment of this
6 Act and shall be sold for such period thereafter as the
7 Postmaster General shall determine.
