## A BILL

To withdraw normal trade relations treatment from, and apply certain provisions of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974 to, the products of the People's Republic of China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WITHDRAWAL OF NORMAL TRADE RELATIONS**  
4 **TREATMENT FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC**  
5 **OF CHINA.**

6 Notwithstanding the provisions of title I of the Act  
7 to authorize extension of nondiscriminatory treatment  
8 (normal trade relations treatment) to the People's Repub-

1 lie of China, and to establish a framework for relations  
2 between the United States and the People’s Republic of  
3 China (Public Law 106–286), or any other provision of  
4 law, effective on the date of the enactment of this Act—

5           (1) normal trade relations treatment shall not  
6           apply pursuant to section 101 of that Act to the  
7           products of the People’s Republic of China;

8           (2) normal trade relations treatment may there-  
9           after be extended to the products of the People’s Re-  
10          public of China only in accordance with the provi-  
11          sions of sections 401 through 409 of the Trade Act  
12          of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2431–2439) as in effect with re-  
13          spect to the products of the People’s Republic of  
14          China on the day before the effective date of the ac-  
15          cession of the People’s Republic of China to the  
16          World Trade Organization; and

17          (3) the extension of waiver authority that was  
18          in effect with respect to the People’s Republic of  
19          China under section 402(d)(1) of the Trade Act of  
20          1974 on the day before the effective date of the ac-  
21          cession of the People’s Republic of China to the  
22          World Trade Organization shall, upon the enactment  
23          of this Act, be deemed not to have expired, and shall

- 1 continue in effect until the date that is 90 days after
- 2 the date of such enactment.
