Mr. Smith of Washington (for himself and Mrs. McMorris Rodgers) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To provide for a Medicaid demonstration project for chronic disease management.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Access
- 5 Project through Information Technology (MAP IT) Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. MEDICAID CHRONIC DISEASE DEMONSTRATION
- 7 PROJECT.
- 8 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Health and
- 9 Human Services (in this section referred to as the "Sec-
- 10 retary") shall establish a 2-year project (in this section

- 1 referred to as the "demonstration project") to dem-
- 2 onstrate the impact of health information technology on
- 3 disease management under the Medicaid program under
- 4 title XIX of the Social Security Act.
- 5 (b) STRUCTURE OF PROJECT.—The demonstration
- 6 project shall—
- 7 (1) create a web-based virtual case management
- 8 tool that provides access to best practices for man-
- 9 aging chronic disease; and
- 10 (2) provide chronic disease patients and care-
- givers access to their own medical records and to a
- single source of information on chronic disease.
- 13 (c) Competition.—Not later than 90 days after the
- 14 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall seek
- 15 proposals from States to carry out the demonstration
- 16 project. The Secretary shall select not less than four pro-
- 17 posals from those submitted by the States, and at least
- 18 one proposal selected shall include a regional approach
- 19 featuring access to an integrated hospital information sys-
- 20 tem in at least two adjoining States that permits the
- 21 measurement of outcomes.
- 22 (d) EVALUATION.—The Secretary shall provide for
- 23 an evaluation of the demonstration project and a deter-
- 24 mination of the amount of cost-savings resulting from the
- 25 project.

- 1 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
- 2 are authorized to be appropriated \$15,000,000 to carry
- 3 out the demonstration project under this section. Funds
- 4 appropriated under this subsection shall remain available

5 until expended without fiscal year limitation.
