# A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to require that, after 5 years, all diesel fuel sold to consumers in the United States for motor vehicles contain not less than 2 percent biofuel, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Energy Independence
- 5 through Bio-diesel Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. 2 PERCENT BIO-FUEL REQUIREMENT.

- 2 Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 3 7545(o)) is amended by adding the following new para-
- 4 graph at the end thereof:
- 5 "(13) 2 PERCENT BIO-FUEL REQUIREMENT.—
- 6 Not later than 1 year after the enactment of this
- 7 paragraph, the Administrator shall promulgate regu-
- 8 lations under this section requiring that, after the
- 9 date 5 years after the enactment of this paragraph,
- all diesel motor vehicle fuel sold or dispensed to con-
- sumers in the contiguous United States, on an an-
- nual average basis, contain not less than 2 percent
- biodiesel (as defined in section 312(f)(1) of the En-
- ergy Policy Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 13220(f)(1)).".
