A BILL

To prevent inappropriate litigation against the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON USE OF APPROPRIATED
- 4 FUNDS.
- 5 None of the sums appropriated in any Act of Con-
- 6 gress, whether enacted before or after the enactment of
- 7 this Act, shall be used or made available to pay any claim
- 8 against the United States by Osvaldo Aldrete-Davila aris-
- 9 ing out of the conduct of Ignacio Ramos, Jose Alonso
- 10 Compean, or any other person engaging in duties as an
- 11 employee of the Government on February 17, 2005.

1 SEC. 2. NONWAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
- 3 United States does not consent to the commencement or
- 4 maintenance of any civil action against the United States
- 5 by Osvaldo Aldrete-Davila arising out of the conduct of
- 6 Ignacio Ramos or Jose Alonso Compean, or any other per-
- 7 son engaging in duties as an employee of the Government
- 8 on February 17, 2005.
