## A BILL

To require each Federal agency to include its address and  
phone number on any agency stationery.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Government Contact  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR FEDERAL AGENCIES TO IN-**  
7 **CLUDE ADDRESSES AND PHONE NUMBERS**  
8 **ON AGENCY STATIONERY.**

9 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Each Federal agency shall in-  
10 clude its address and phone number on any agency sta-

1 tionery. In the case of correspondence originating from a  
2 regional or local office of a Federal agency, the agency  
3 shall include the address and phone number of the re-  
4 gional or local office on the stationery.

5 (b) AGENCY DEFINITION.—In this Act, the term  
6 “Federal agency” has the meaning provided the term “Ex-  
7 ecutive agency” by section 105 of title 5, United States  
8 Code.

9 (c) EXCEPTION FOR NATIONAL SECURITY.—Sub-  
10 section (a) shall not apply in any case in which compliance  
11 with such subsection would not be in the national security  
12 interests of the United States, as determined by the head  
13 of the agency.

14 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect  
15 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
