A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. MASS TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AND TRAV- 4 ELER INFORMATION SERVICES FOR EMER- 5 GENCIES.

6 (a) ELIGIBILITY FOR MASS TRANSPORTATION.—Sec-
7 tion 125(d) of title 23, United States Code, is amended

1 by inserting after “ferryboats” the following: “and addi-
2 tional mass transportation services, including the oper-
3 ation of traveler information services.”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall apply to mass transportation services
6 provided as temporary substitute highway traffic services
7 eligible for emergency relief under section 125(d) of title
8 23, United States Code, on or after April 29, 2007.
