A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend for 6 months the eligibility period for the “Welcome to Medicare” physical examination and to eliminate coinsurance for screening mammography and colorectal cancer screening tests in order to promote the early detection of cancer.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Early Detec-
3 tion of Cancer Promotion Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING THE ELIGIBILITY PERIOD FOR A “WEL-
5 COME TO MEDICARE” PHYSICAL EXAMINA-
6 TION FROM SIX MONTHS TO ONE YEAR.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1862(a)(1)(K) of the So-
8 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)(1)(K)) is amended
9 by striking “6 months” and inserting “1 year”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall apply to initial preventive physician
12 examinations performed on or after January 1, 2008.

13 **SEC. 3. ELIMINATION OF THE 20 PERCENT COINSURANCE
14 FOR SCREENING MAMMOGRAPHY AND
15 COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING TESTS.**

16 (a) SCREENING MAMMOGRAPHY.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1833(a)(1)(B) of the
18 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(a)(1)(B)) is
19 amended—

20 (A) by inserting “and with respect to
21 screening mammography (as defined in section
22 1861(jj))” after “section 1861(s)(10)(A)”; and

23 (B) by striking “100 percent of the reason-
24 able charge for such items and services” and in-
25 serting “100 percent of the fee schedule or
26 other basis of payment under this title for the

1 vaccine and its administration or for the screen-
2 ing mammography”.

3 (2) APPLICATION TO OUTPATIENT HOSPITAL
4 SETTINGS.—The third sentence of section
5 1866(a)(2)(A) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
6 1395ee(a)(2)(A)) is amended by inserting after
7 “1861(s)(10)(A)” the following: “, with respect to
8 screening mammography,.”.

9 (b) COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING TESTS.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(d) of such Act
11 (42 U.S.C. 1395m(d)) is amended—

12 (A) in paragraph (2)(C)—

13 (i) by striking “FACILITY PAYMENT
14 LIMIT” and all that follows through “Not-
15 withstanding subsections” and inserting
16 “FACILITY PAYMENT LIMIT.—Notwith-
17 standing subsections”;

18 (ii) by striking “(I) in accordance”
19 and inserting “(i) in accordance”;

20 (iii) by striking “(II) are performed”
21 and all that follows through “payment
22 under” and inserting “(ii) are performed
23 in an ambulatory surgical center or hos-
24 pital outpatient department, payment
25 under”; and

1 (iv) by striking clause (ii); and

2 (B) in paragraph (3)(C)—

3 (i) by striking “FACILITY PAYMENT
4 LIMIT” and all that follows through “Not-
5 withstanding subsections” and inserting
6 “FACILITY PAYMENT LIMIT.—Notwith-
7 standing subsections”; and

⁸ (ii) by striking clause (ii)

19 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
20 this section shall apply to screening mammography and
21 colorectal cancer screening tests performed on or after
22 January 1, 2008.

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
