Mr. THOMPSON of California (for himself, Mr. MURTHA, Mr. GEORGE MILLER of California, and Ms. MATSUI) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To require the immediate redeployment of United States
Armed Forces from Iraq.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Iraq Redeployment and

5 Regional Security Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMMEDIATE REDEPLOYMENT OF UNITED STATES**2 **ARMED FORCES FROM IRAQ.**

3 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act, the President shall commence the full
5 redeployment of all United States Armed Forces from
6 Iraq. The redeployment required by this section shall be
7 completed within 1 year after the date of the enactment
8 of this Act.

9 **SEC. 3. MIDDLE EASTERN REGIONAL DIPLOMACY.**

10 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—As soon as practicable after the
11 date of the enactment of this Act, the President shall insti-
12 tute a regional diplomatic plan, in conjunction with the
13 United Nations Security Council, that will attempt to ac-
14 complish the following objectives:

- 15 (1) Curtail the ongoing civil war in Iraq.
- 16 (2) Contain the civil war in Iraq to prevent its
17 spread into neighboring countries.
- 18 (3) Prevent the establishment of al Qaeda safe
19 havens.
- 20 (4) Prevent regional war.
- 21 (5) Prevent genocide.

22 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 30 days after the date
23 of the enactment of this Act, and every 30 days thereafter,
24 the President shall transmit to Congress a report on the
25 status of the regional diplomatic plan required by sub-
26 section (a) and the progress being made to accomplish the

- 1 objectives described in paragraphs (1) through (5) of such
- 2 subsection.
