- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Prohibition Against
- 5 Criminal Alien Reentry Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASED CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN
- 7 REMOVED ALIENS.
- 8 Section 276(b) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1326(b)) is amended—
- 10 (1) in paragraph (1)—

1	(A) by striking "three" and inserting
2	"two", and
3	(B) by striking "10" and inserting "20";
4	(2) in paragraph (2), by striking "20" and in-
5	serting "30";
6	(3) in paragraph (3), by striking "10" and in-
7	serting "20"; and
8	(4) in paragraph (4), by striking "10" and in-
9	serting "20".
