To require that the recommended national protocol for sexual assault medical forensic examinations include a recommendation that rape victims be offered information about emergency contraceptives to prevent pregnancy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Best Help for Rape
- 5 Victims Act".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIRED ELEMENT OF NATIONAL PROTOCOL FOR
2	SEXUAL ASSAULT MEDICAL FORENSIC EX-
3	AMINATIONS.
4	(a) In General.—Section 1405 of the Violence
5	Against Women Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. $3796gg$ note) is
6	amended—
7	(1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-
8	section (e); and
9	(2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
10	lowing new subsection:
11	"(d) Required Element of Protocol.—The na-
12	tional protocol required by subsection (a)(3) shall include
13	a recommendation to the effect that a victim of sexual as-
14	sault who is at risk of pregnancy from rape—
15	"(1) should be offered information about emer-
16	gency contraception; and
17	"(2) should, if the victim so requests, be pro-
18	vided with emergency contraception on site.".
19	(b) Implementation to Protocol Already
20	Issued.—The Attorney General shall ensure that any
21	protocol already issued under section $1405(a)(3)$ of the Vi-
22	olence Against Women Act of 2000 is, not later than 30
23	days after the date of the enactment of this Act, revised
24	and reissued in a form that complies with section $1405(\mathrm{d})$
25	of that Act (as added by subsection (a)(2) of this section).
