## AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to carry out a study to determine the suitability and feasibility of establishing Camp Hale as a unit of the National Park System.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Camp Hale Study
- 3 Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY OF THE SUITABILITY
- 5 AND FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING CAMP
- 6 HALE AS A UNIT OF THE NATIONAL PARK
- 7 SYSTEM.
- 8 (a) In General.—The Secretary of the Interior, act-
- 9 ing through the Director of the National Park Service,
- 10 (hereinafter referred to as the "Secretary") shall complete
- 11 a special resource study of Camp Hale to determine—
- 12 (1) the suitability and feasibility of designating
- 13 Camp Hale as a separate unit of the National Park
- 14 System; and
- 15 (2) the methods and means for the protection
- and interpretation of Camp Hale by the National
- 17 Park Service, other Federal, State, or local govern-
- ment entities or private or nonprofit organizations.
- 19 (b) STUDY REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary shall
- 20 conduct the study in accordance with section 8(c) of Pub-
- 21 lie Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5).
- (c) Report.—Not later than 3 years after the date
- 23 on which funds are made available to carry out this Act,
- 24 the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Natural
- 25 Resources of the House of Representatives and the Com-

5	SEC. 3. EFFECT OF STUDY.
6	Nothing in this Act shall affect valid existing rights
7	including—
8	(1) all interstate water compacts in existence or
9	the date of the enactment of this Act (including ful
10	development of any apportionment made in accord
11	ance with the compacts);
12	(2) water rights decreed at the Camp Hale site
13	or flowing within, below, or through the Camp Hale
14	site;
15	(3) water rights in the State of Colorado;
16	(4) water rights held by the United States; and
17	(5) the management and operation of any res
18	ervoir, including the storage, management, release
19	or transportation of water.
