A BILL

To expand the Project Safe Neighborhoods program, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safe Neighborhoods
5 Expansion Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENHANCEMENT OF PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBOR-**
7 **HOODS INITIATIVE TO IMPROVE ENFORCE-**
8 **MENT OF CRIMINAL LAWS AGAINST VIOLENT**
9 **GANGS.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—While maintaining the focus of
11 Project Safe Neighborhoods as a comprehensive, strategic

1 approach to reducing gun violence in America, the Attor-
2 ney General is authorized to expand the Project Safe
3 Neighborhoods program to require each United States at-
4 torney to—

5 (1) identify, investigate, and prosecute signifi-
6 cant criminal street gangs operating within their dis-
7 trict; and

8 (2) coordinate the identification, investigation,
9 and prosecution of criminal street gangs among Fed-
10 eral, State, and local law enforcement agencies.

11 (b) ADDITIONAL STAFF FOR PROJECT SAFE NEIGH-
12 BORHOODS.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General may
14 hire Assistant United States attorneys, non-attorney
15 coordinators, or paralegals to carry out the provi-
16 sions of this section.

17 (2) ENFORCEMENT.—The Attorney General
18 may hire Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and
19 Explosives agents for, and otherwise expend addi-
20 tional resources in support of, the Project Safe
21 Neighborhoods/Firearms Violence Reduction pro-
22 gram.

23 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
24 are authorized to be appropriated \$20,000,000 for each
25 of the fiscal years 2008 through 2012 to carry out this

- 1 section. Any funds made available under this subsection
- 2 shall remain available until expended.
