A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Employee Educational
- 5 Assistance Act of 2007".

- 1 SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FOR EMPLOYER-PROVIDED EDU-
- 2 CATIONAL ASSISTANCE MADE PERMANENT.
- 3 Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
- 4 Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall not apply to section 411

5 of such Act.

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
