## A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to provide for payment of lump-sum death payments upon the death of a spouse.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF LUMP-SUM DEATH PAYMENTS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Section 202(i) of the Social Secu-
- 5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(i)) is amended by striking "(i)
- 6 Upon the death" and all that follows through "individual's
- 7 death." in paragraph (2) and inserting the following:
- 8 "(i)(1) Upon the death of an individual who died as
- 9 a fully or currently insured individual or as the spouse

- 1 of a fully or currently insured individual, an amount equal
- 2 to the lesser of—
- 3 "(A) three times the applicable primary insur-
- 4 ance amount determined under paragraph (3), or
- 5 "(B) \$255,
- 6 shall be payable under this subsection.
- 7 "(2) Payments under this subsection in connection
- 8 with a deceased individual shall be paid—
- 9 "(A) to the surviving spouse of the individual,
- 10 or
- "(B) if no person qualifies for payment under
- subparagraph (A), or if such person dies before re-
- ceiving payment, in equal shares to each person who
- is entitled (or would have been so entitled had a
- timely application been filed), either on the basis of
- the wages and self-employment income of any such
- person who dies before receiving payment or on the
- basis of the wages and self-employment income of
- the deceased individual referred to in paragraph (1),
- to benefits under subsection (d) of this section for
- 21 the month in which the relevant death occurred.
- 22 "(3) For purposes of paragraph (1)(A), the applica-
- 23 ble primary insurance amount determined under this para-
- 24 graph is the larger of—

1 "(A) the deceased individual's primary insur-2 ance amount (if any), determined without regard to 3 the amendments made by section 2201 of the Omni-4 bus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981, relating to 5 repeal of the minimum benefit provisions, or 6 "(B) the primary insurance amount (if any) which would be so determined with respect to the 7 8 surviving spouse of the deceased individual if such 9 spouse had died on the date of the death of the de-10 ceased individual.". 11 (b) Conforming Amendments.—Section 202(i) of such Act is amended— 12 (1) by striking "No payment" and inserting the 13 14 following: "(4) No payment"; 15 (2) by striking "such insured individual" each 16 17 place it appears and inserting "the deceased indi-18 vidual referred to in paragraph (1)"; (3) by striking "In the case of any individual 19 20 who died outside the forty-eight" and inserting the 21 following: "(5) In the case of any individual who died outside 22 23 the forty-eight"; 24 (4) by striking "the provisions of the preceding sentence" and inserting "paragraph (4)"; 25

1	(5) by striking "the second sentence of" each

3	(6) by striking "In the case of any individual
4	who died outside the fifty" and inserting the fol-
5	lowing:
6	"(6) In the case of any individual who died outside
7	the fifty"; and
8	(7) by striking "the provisions of the third sen-

10	(4)".
11	SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	The amendments made by section 1 shall apply with
13	respect to deaths occurring after 180 days after the date
