3	SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CLOSURE OR RELOCATION
4	OF FARM SERVICE AGENCY FIELD OFFICE IN

6	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-
7	ings:
8	(1) Clark County, Indiana, contains 638 sepa-
9	rate farms, which together generate annual farm in-
10	come of approximately \$32,000,000.

1	(2) These 638 farms encompass 72,000 acres of
2	cropland, 20,000 acres of pastureland, and 17,000
3	acres of woodland

- (3) If the field office of the Farm Service Agency in Clark County is closed, as proposed by the Secretary of Agriculture, some Clark County farmers would have to travel more than an hour to the nearest FSA office, expending time and fuel on unnecessary travel.
- 10 (4) Clark County farmers have fewer options to 11 travel to other FSA offices because the Ohio River 12 forms one of the borders of the County.
- 13 (b) PROHIBITION.—The Secretary of Agriculture 14 may not close or relocate the field office of the Farm Serv-15 ice Agency in Clark County, Indiana, until at least two 16 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
