## A BILL

To require rate integration for wireless interstate toll charges.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Insular Rate for Cel-
- 5 lular Customers Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RATE INTEGRATION FOR WIRELESS COMMUNICA-
- 7 TIONS SERVICES.
- 8 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 254(g) of the Commu-
- 9 nications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254(g)) is amended by
- 10 adding at the end the following: "For the purposes of the

- 1 preceding sentence, a provider of a commercial mobile
- 2 radio service shall, with respect to any interstate services,
- 3 be treated as a provider of interstate, interexchange tele-
- 4 communications services.".
- 5 (b) Implementation.—The Federal Communica-
- 6 tions Commission shall adopt revisions to its rules under
- 7 section 254(g) of such Act to implement the amendment
- 8 made by subsection (a) within 6 months after the date
- 9 of enactment of this Act.
