## A BILL

To delay for 6 months the requirement to use tamper-resistant prescription pads under the Medicaid Program.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. 6-MONTH DELAY IN REQUIREMENT TO USE**  
4                       **TAMPER-RESISTANT    PRESCRIPTION    PADS**  
5                       **UNDER MEDICAID.**

6       Effective as if included in the enactment of section  
7       7002(b) of the U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care,  
8       Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations  
9       Act, 2007 (Public Law 110–28, 121 Stat. 187), paragraph

1 (2) of such section is amended by striking “September 30,  
2 2007” and inserting “March 31, 2008”.
