## AN ACT

To amend the Foreign Service Act of 1980 to permit rest and recuperation travel to United States territories for members of the Foreign Service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF UNITED STATES TERRITORIES**2 **AS ELIGIBLE FOR REST AND RECUPERATION**  
3 **TRAVEL FOR MEMBERS OF THE FOREIGN**  
4 **SERVICE.**

5 The Foreign Service Act of 1980 is amended—

6 (1) in section 901(B) (22 U.S.C. 4081(B)), by inserting after “United States” the  
7 following: “or its territories, including American  
8 Samoa, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam,  
9 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Is-  
10 lands, and the United States Virgin Islands”; and11 (2) in section 903(b) (22 U.S.C. 4083(b)), by  
12 striking “, its territories and possessions, or the  
13 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico” and inserting “or its  
14 territories, including American Samoa, the Com-  
15 monwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the Commonwealth of  
16 the Northern Mariana Islands, and the United  
17 States Virgin Islands”.18
