AN ACT

To amend the Foreign Service Act of 1980 to permit rest and recuperation travel to United States territories for members of the Foreign Service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF UNITED STATES TERRITORIES**
2 **AS ELIGIBLE FOR REST AND RECUPERATION**
3 **TRAVEL FOR MEMBERS OF THE FOREIGN**
4 **SERVICE.**

5 The Foreign Service Act of 1980 is amended—

6 (1) in section 901(6)(B) (22 U.S.C.
7 4081(6)(B)), by inserting after “United States” the
8 following: “or its territories, including American
9 Samoa, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam,
10 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Is-
11 lands, and the United States Virgin Islands”; and

12 (2) in section 903(b) (22 U.S.C. 4083(b)), by
13 striking “, its territories and possessions, or the
14 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico” and inserting “or its
15 territories, including American Samoa, the Common-
16 wealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the Commonwealth of
17 the Northern Mariana Islands, and the United
18 States Virgin Islands”.
