To amend title 46, United States Code, to promote the U.S. distant water tuna fleet.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "South Pacific Tuna
- 5 Fleet Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. FISHING IN SOUTH PACIFIC TUNA TREATY CONVEN-
- 7 TION AREA.
- 8 (a) Fishery Endorsements.—Section 12108 of
- 9 title 46, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
- 10 end the following new subsection:

- 1 "(e) A fishery endorsement is not required for a
- 2 United States documented purse seine tuna fishing vessel
- 3 home ported in American Samoa while fishing exclusively
- 4 for highly migratory species under a license issued pursu-
- 5 ant to the 1987 Treaty on Fisheries Between the Govern-
- 6 ments of Certain Pacific Island States and the Govern-
- 7 ment of the United States of America in the treaty area
- 8 or in United States exclusive economic zones bordering the
- 9 treaty area.".
- 10 (b) Effective Date.—This Act shall become effec-
- 11 tive upon date of enactment.
