A BILL

To direct the Consumer Product Safety Commission to investigate the potential safety dangers in children's clothing and to promulgate any necessary consumer product safety rules regarding such clothing.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY STANDARDS FOR
- 4 CHILDREN'S CLOTHING.
- 5 (a) Investigation.—Not later than 6 months after
- 6 the date of enactment of this Act, the Consumer Product
- 7 Safety Commission shall complete an investigation of chil-
- 8 dren's clothing to examine and identify potential safety

- 1 hazards which exist in such clothing. The investigation
- 2 shall focus on imported children's clothing and shall con-
- 3 sider the potential danger to a child of all aspects of a
- 4 product.
- 5 (b) Consumer Product Safety Rule.—Not later
- 6 than 6 months after completing the investigation required
- 7 under subsection (a), the Commission shall promulgate a
- 8 consumer product safety rule regarding any safety hazards
- 9 identified in such investigation and establishing any nec-
- 10 essary safety standards for such products.
- 11 (c) Children's Clothing Defined.—As used in
- 12 this Act, the term "children's clothing" means any article
- 13 of clothing, including shoes, intended to be worn or used
- 14 by children under the age of 8, or for which the wearing
- 15 by a child under the age of 8 is foreseeable.
