3 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR KEWEENAW NATIONAL HISTOR-**
4 **ICAL PARK.**

5 (a) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—Section 4 of Public
6 Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–3) is amended by striking
7 subsection (d).

1 (b) MATCHING FUNDS.—Section 8(b) of Public Law
2 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–7(b)) is amended by striking
3 “\$4” and inserting “\$1”.

4 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
5 10 of Public Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–9) is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) by striking “\$25,000,000” and insert-
9 ing “\$50,000,000”; and

10 (B) by striking “\$3,000,000” and insert-
11 ing “\$25,000,000”; and

12 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$100,000”
13 and all that follows through “those duties” and in-
14 serting “\$250,000”.
