3 **SECTION 1. INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS TO INCREASE LEARN-
4 ING IN FINANCIAL LITERACY.**

5 Section 5131(a) of the Elementary and Secondary
6 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7215(a)) is amended
7 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(28) Programs to increase learning in finan-
2 cial literacy, either through classroom learning or
3 after school programs.”.
