5	(a) Length of Period.—Section 3011 of title 38,
6	United States Code, is amended—
7	(1) in subsection $(a)(1)(A)(ii)$ , by striking "an
8	obligated period of service of two years" and insert-
9	ing "an obligated period of service of less than three
10	years'';
11	(2) in subsection (b)(2), by striking "two years
12	of"; and
13	(3) in subsection (d)(3), by inserting before the
14	period the following: ", unless the individual com-
15	pleted at least 20 months of continuous service on
16	active duty".
17	(b) Technical Amendment.—Section 3012(c)(2)
18	of such title is amended by striking "two years of".
19	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
20	this Act shall apply with respect to education or training
21	pursued on or after the date of enactment of this Act by
22	an individual who, on or after September 11, 2001, begins
23	serving the obligated period of active duty described in sec-
24	tion 3011(a)(1)(A)(ii) of title 38, United States Code, as
25	amended by subsection (a)(1).
