- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Brownfields Redevelop-
- 5 ment Promotion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPENSING OF ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION
- 7 COSTS MADE PERMANENT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 198 of the Internal Rev-
- 9 enue Code of 1986 (relating to expensing of environmental
- 10 remediation costs) is amended by striking subsection (h).

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 this section shall apply to expenditures paid or incurred

3 after December 31, 2007.
